

Medicare Part D Standard Zero Premium Prescription Drug Plans in 2009

In Pennsylvania, all dual eligibles and those who receive a full low income subsidy (LIS) will have no premium if they enroll in any of these 9 Part D stand-alone Prescription Drug Plans in 2009. Dual eligibles and those with a full LIS will also have no deductible, no donut hole and will only have small co-pays (from \$1.10 - \$6.00) for each of their prescription medications.
