

Breast and Cervical Cancer
Prevention and Treatment
Program (BCCPTP)

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This program provides free Medical Assistance coverage to women who have breast or cervical cancer (or pre-cancerous conditions) and who meet the other eligibility requirements. Women who are eligible receive comprehensive health care coverage through the Fee-for-Service Medical Assistance Program.

BCCPTP Requirements:

Women in PA are eligible for this program who:

- have a household income under 250% FPL;
- are under age 65;
- are PA Residents;
- are US Citizen or lawfully admitted immigrants;
- are uninsured (No creditable coverage);
- are Screened/Diagnosed through a CDC-approved **HEALTHY WOMAN** site (a list of which can be found at <http://www.health.state.pa.us/php/HW/hltwlist.htm>)
