

2011 Medicare Part D Standard Zero Premium Prescription Drug Plans

In Pennsylvania, all dual eligibles and those who receive a full low income subsidy (LIS) will have no premium if they enroll in any of these 12 Part D stand-alone Prescription Drug Plans in 2010. **Dual eligibles** and **those with a full LIS** will also have no deductible, no donut hole, and will only have small co-pays for each of their medications. Plans with an asterisk (*) will be zero-premium for all members with the full LIS; however, Medicare will not auto-enroll or reassign full LIS recipients to these plans.
