

## 2014 Medicare Part D Standard Zero Premium Prescription Drug Plans

In Pennsylvania, all dual eligibles and those who receive a full low-income subsidy (LIS) will have no premium if they enroll in any of these 11 Part D stand-alone Prescription Drug Plans in 2014. **Dual eligibles** and **those with a full LIS** will also have no deductible, no donut hole, and will only have small co-pays for each of their medication. Please note that dual eligibles who receive Medicaid-covered nursing home care or who receive long-term care services through a Medicaid Waiver program have no co-pays for Part D covered medications.
