

Do You Need Health Insurance?

Pennsylvania has expanded Medicaid! It now covers almost all low-income adults.

Do I qualify for free coverage?

Here are the monthly Medicaid income limits for adults. Some adults, such as pregnant women and people with disabilities, have higher income limits.

	1 person	2 people	3 people
Adults 138% poverty	\$1,367	\$1,843	\$2,319

How do I apply?

If you think you qualify for Medicaid, apply anytime:

- **Online:** www.compass.state.pa.us
- **Over the phone:** (866) 550-4355

If you are over the income limit for Medicaid, you can apply for insurance through HealthCare.gov. Many people get help paying for coverage. Open enrollment has ended for 2016 but you may qualify for a “special enrollment period.”
